

Vietnam: Changes to Visa Policies

UK & EUROPEAN CITIZENS

VISA ON ARRIVAL

- Visa on Arrival (VOA) letters with an issue date up until 9 March 2020 have been accepted.
- Visa on Arrival letters that have not yet been issued can be issued for guests as of 10 March 2020. However, the process for obtaining VOA letters has changed. Visa on Arrival letters may now take up to ten (10) working days.

VISA EXEMPTIONS

 From 9 March 2020, visa exemptions will be denied for travelers holding passports from the United Kingdom, Italy, Spain, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Finland, Germany, France, or Spain.

HEALTH DECLARATIONS

- All guests are obligated to make medication declarations before entering Vietnam.
 Please contact us for the form in advance for your clients to avoid additional queues on the ground.

- Please note: After completing the health declaration, if any traveler is deemed to exhibit any symptoms of illness, they may be denied entry at the discretion of the local Vietnamese government.
